1. Plan requirements for your fee proposal

Wondering how to get started with the Building Approvals (BA) process?

Provide architectural plans from a licensed design professional / draftsperson, including:

- location of existing structures and main infrastructure
- North point, elevations / heights
- details of fences/ boundaries on site
- accurate dimensions of all outbuildings / sheds, including site coverage and distances to outermost projection (OMP)
- details of the natural ground level (NGL) and reduced levels (RLs) as well materials proposed

Certifiers work closely with the design professional / project stakeholders such as builder and town planner as required, depending on site specific contexts. A specific list or required documents will be provided by the certifier, after assessment (Request for Information - RFI).

2. Documents commonly required in the beginning stages of your Building Approval (BA)

- "For BA" final plan set (with livable housing details, site plan, floor plan, elevations/ sections/ bracing insights as/if applicable)
- Form 15 engineering
- Engineering plans
- QBCC insurance
- Referral documentation eg siting variation / BOS, BOSW if applicable, depending on site
- Soil test*
- Energy report*
- QLeave*
- Soil tests liaise with your engineer for best insights into timing/ services required

*These documents are generally required for residential building work.
